Mandatory rules briefing begins.</p> <p>** At least 1 team member MUST attend! ** All Anglers must be off the water by 4 p.m. on the day of the rules meeting.</p>	<p><u>Launch/Weigh-In</u></p> <p>Place: Barto Landing</p> <p>Take-off will begin at 8 a.m. or safe light First flight due in at 4 p.m.</p> <p>Only anglers may park at Barto Landing, spectators should park at Hall High School and take the shuttle over.</p> <p><u>Host Club</u> Spring Valley Walleye Club Site Coordinator: William Guerrini</p>	<p><u>Inspections</u></p> <p>Inspection will be held during lineup for takeoff. Live wells must be empty.</p> <p><u>Required Safety Equipment</u> It is the responsibility of all anglers to have required state and federal safety equipment on board.</p> <p>At time of inspection each morning, be prepared to display 1 life jacket for each angler; 1 throw able PFD; and demonstrate functioning kill switch.</p>
<p><u>Fish & Tackle Limits</u></p> <p>Fish size: walleyes, saugers and saugeyes 14 inches and over.</p> <p>Teams are allowed to weigh a limit of 5 fish per team per day.</p> <p>Culling is legal with a limit of 10 fish in the live well. Release any fish not to be weighed in prior to making final run to check-in.</p> <p>Fish which fail to measure the official length limits shall incur a one pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish. Any dead fish penalties are 8 ounces per fish.</p> <p>No more than two fishing rods with one lure each, or one fishing rod with two lures per angler may be used at a time unless the state or lake limit is more restrictive, in which case the state or lake limit will prevail.</p>	<p><u>Host Hotel</u></p> <p>Days Inn, Oglesby, IL. 120 N Lewis, Ave. Exit 54 Oglesby, Il 61348 815-833-9600</p> <p>-Boat slip rentals are available at the Spring Valley Boat Club. \$15/day, 3-day minimum.
