Fish Limits

Fish size: 14" and over.

Each angler is allowed 1 fish over 20". 3 fish per angler, teams may weigh 5 fish per team per day.

Culling is allowed.

One rod per angler.

Any fish presented for weigh-in which fails to measure the official length limits shall accrue penalties at the rate of one pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish.

Inspection will be held during lineup for takeoff. Live wells must be empty.

Tournament Waters\ Info

We Lead. We Find. You Win.™

Keep marine band radios on Channel 72 for tournament information, and use Channel 16 for emergencies.

Boundaries: Cass Lake Chain of Lakes (Cass Lake, Buck Lake, Lake Andrusia, Big Wolf Lake, Kitchi Lake, Pike Bay).

The tournament waters for this event shall be the Stockton Lake and shall include all rivers, creeks and canals connecting to the above-mentioned waters. Any waters within these boundaries posted Off-limits or No Fishing by State or Federal Agencies will be Off-Limits. Any live release areas established by the Tour Director will be Off-limits, that as well as any additional off-limits will be announced at the pretournament briefing. Only that water open to ALL public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's contestants.

All Local, State & Federal Regulations Apply.

Minnesota fishing license is required.

If keeping bait, you must exchange water in bait buckets with tap or bottled water prior to leaving any water body to prevent the spread of aquatic invasive species or fish diseases.

Drain plugs must be removed from bilges and live wells at the water access. Drain plugs must be out and all other water draining devices must remain open while trailering or transporting boats.
