Detailed payback will be always be announced at every rules briefing.</p>	<p><u>Inspections:</u> Inspection will be held during lineup for takeoff. Live wells must be empty.</p> <p><u>Place:</u> Spring Valley Boat Club 13862 Illinois 89, Granville, IL 61326</p> <p>Take-off will begin at 7:00 a.m. or safe light.</p> <p>First flight due in at 3:00 p.m.</p>	<p><u>Rules & Safety Equipment</u> Keep marine band radios on Channel 72 for tournament information, and use Channel 16 for emergencies.</p> <p>Boundaries: Lock at your own risk, The tournament waters for this event shall be the Illinois River and shall include all rivers, creeks and canals connecting to the above-mentioned waters. Any waters within these boundaries posted Off-limits or No Fishing by State or Federal Agencies will be Off-Limits. Any live release areas established by the Tour Director will be Off-limits, that as well as any additional off-limits will be announced at the pre-tournament briefing. Only that water open to ALL public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's contestants. All Local, State & Federal Regulations Apply. Illinois Department of Natural Resources will collect and utilize our catch for the states spawning process.</p> <p><u>Required Safety Equipment</u> It is the responsibility of all anglers to have required functional state and federal safety equipment on board. At time of inspection each morning, be prepared to display 1 life jacket for each angler; 1 throw able PFD; and demonstrate functioning kill switch.</p>

<p><u>Fish size:</u> Walleyes, Saugers & Saugeyes - 14 inches and over.</p> <p>Teams are allowed to weigh a limit of 5 fish per team per day. Culling is legal with a limit of 10 fish in the livewell. Release any fish not to be weighed in prior to making final run to check-in.</p> <p>Any fish presented for weigh-in which fails to measure the official length limits shall accrue penalties at the rate of one pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish.</p>	<p>Spring Valley Boat Club Phone: (815) 664-2609 Covered boat slips available.
