Live wells must be empty.</p> <p><u>Place:</u> Chapton Harbor 9 Mile Ramp St. Clair Shores, MI 48080</p> <p>Take-off will begin at 7:00 am or first safe light.</p> <p>First flight due in at 3:00 p.m.</p>	<p align="center"><b><u>Tournament Water \ Info</u></b></p> <p>Keep marine band radios on Channel 72 for tournament information, and use Channel 16 for emergencies.</p> <p><b>Boundaries:</b> None</p> <p>The tournament waters for this event shall be Lake Saint Clair, the Detroit river and shall include all rivers, lakes, creeks and canals connecting to the above-mentioned waters legal to fish by law. Any waters within these boundaries posted Off-limits or No Fishing by State or Federal Agencies will be Off-Limits. Any live release areas established by the Tour Director will be Off-limits, that as well as any additional off-limits will be announced at the pre-tournament briefing. Only that water open to ALL public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's contestants.</p> <p>All Local, State &amp; Federal\Canadian Regulations Apply.</p>
<p align="center"><b><u>Fish Limits</u></b></p> <p>Fish size: 15 inches and over.</p> <p>Teams are allowed to weigh a limit of 5 fish per team per day.
