 Walleyes, Saugers & Saugeyes – 15 inches and over. Teams are allowed to weigh a limit of 5 fish per team per day, and a limit of 10 fish in the livewell. Release any fish not to be weighed in prior to making final run to check-in. Any fish presented for weigh-in which fails to measure the official length limits shall accrue penalties at the rate of one pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish. Wisconsin regulations anglers are allowed 2 rods with 3 hooks, baits, or lures per angler.
