## Launch/Weigh-In Information

#### Weigh-in/Launch Site:

Riverside Park

Latitude: 45-18'10" N Longitude: 096-27'01" W

Take-off will begin at 7:00 am or first

safe light

First flight due in at 4:00pm

-Day 1 will be Friday or Saturday, and Day 2 Saturday or Sunday – Depending on weather conditions.

#### Required Safety Equipment

It is the responsibility of all anglers to have required state and federal safety equipment on board.

At time of inspection each morning, be prepared to display 1 life jacket for each angler; 1 throw able PFD; and demonstrate functioning kill switch.

Keep marine band radios on Channel 72 for any tournament information, and use Channel 16 for emergencies.

#### Fish Limits

Fish size: 15" and over Any fish presented for weigh-in which fails to measure the official length limits shall accrue penalties at the rate of one pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish

Each angler is allowed 1 fish over 20"

Culling is not allowed.

Two Rods per angler

MN and SD Fishing License is Reciprocal

5 fish per team, 8 fish in the live well. 4 fish per person.

#### **Tournament Information**

If keeping bait, you must exchange water in bait buckets with tap or bottled water prior to leaving any water body to prevent the spread of aquatic invasive species or fish diseases

Drain plugs must be removed from bilges and live wells at the water access. Drain plugs must be out and all other water draining devices must remain open while trailering or transporting boats.

An 8 ounce deduction will be made for each fish presented to the bump master for weighing that is determined to be non-releasable
