Live wells must be empty.</p> <p><u>Place:</u> Lake Side Park 315 Madison Ave Ortonville, MN 56278</p> <p>Take-off will begin at 7:00 a.m. or safe light.</p> <p>First flight due in at 3:00 p.m.</p>	<p>Keep marine band radios on Channel 72 for tournament information, and use Channel 16 for emergencies.</p> <p><b>Boundaries:</b> None</p> <p>The tournament waters for this event shall be the Big Stone Lake and shall include all rivers, creeks and canals connecting to the above-mentioned waters. Any waters within these boundaries posted Off-limits or No Fishing by State or Federal Agencies will be Off-Limits. Any live release areas established by the Tour Director will be Off-limits, that as well as any additional off-limits will be announced at the pre-tournament briefing. Only that water open to ALL public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's contestants.</p> <p>All Local, State &amp; Federal Regulations Apply.</p>
<p><u>Fish Limits</u></p> <p>Fish size: 15" and over.
