| <p><u>Registration/Rules Meeting Information</u></p> <p><u>Place:</u> Petenwell County Park <u>Date:</u> Thursday, June 25 <u>Times:</u> 4:00 p.m. - Opens for Non-Premier Teams 5:00 p.m. - Opens for PREMIER Teams 5:45 p.m. - Registration CLOSES *6:00 p.m. SHARP! - Mandatory rules briefing begins.</p> <p>At least 1 team member MUST attend!</p> <p>All Anglers must be off the water by 4 p.m. on the day of the rules meeting.</p> <p>Payback schedule is outlined in the MWC rules. Detailed payback will be announced at every rules briefing as always.</p> | <p><u>Launch/Weigh-In</u></p> <p><u>Inspections:</u> Inspection will be held during lineup for takeoff. Live wells must be empty.</p> <p><u>Place:</u> Petenwell Park</p> <p>Take-off will begin at 7:00 a.m. or safe light.</p> <p>First flight due in at 3:00 p.m.</p> | <p><u>Tournament Waters\ Info</u> <u>Rules & Safety Equipment</u></p> <p>Keep marine band radios on Channel 72 for tournament information, and use Channel 16 for emergencies.</p> <p>Boundaries: Tournament waters for this event shall be the Petenwell Lake and shall include all rivers, creeks and canals connecting to the above-mentioned waters. Any waters within these boundaries posted Off-limits or No Fishing by State or Federal Agencies will be Off-Limits. Any live release areas established by the Tour Director will be Off-limits, that as well as any additional off-limits will be announced at the pre-tournament briefing. Only that water open to ALL public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's contestants. All Local, State & Federal Regulations Apply.</p> <p><u>Required Safety Equipment</u> It is the responsibility of all anglers to have required functional state and federal safety equipment on board. At time of inspection each morning, be prepared to display 1 life jacket for each angler; 1 throw able PFD; and demonstrate functioning kill switch.</p> |
| <p><u>Fish Limits</u></p> <p>Fish size: 15" and over. Walleye, Sauger & Hybrids – 20"-28" may not be kept. Each angler is allowed 1 fish over 28". 3 fish per angler with 6 in the live well, teams may weigh 5 fish per team per day. Release remaining fish before making your run to the launch prior to weigh-in.</p> <p>Culling is illegal. Three baits per angler.
