Fish size: 15" and over. Walleye, Sauger & Hybrids – 20"-28" may not be kept. Each angler is allowed 1 fish over 28". 3 fish per angler with 6 in the live well, teams may weigh 5 fish per team per day. Release remaining fish before making your run to the launch prior to weigh-in. Culling is illegal. Three baits per angler.
