Fish Limits 15" minimum. 5 fish limit. 1 fish over 23" per angler. No more than 3 lines per person, with no more than 6 hooks/lures. All hooks attached to artificial bait or "night crawler harness" are counted as 1 hook. Hooks must be baited or attached to artificial bait. Culling is legal. Any fish presented for weigh-in which fails to measure the official length limits shall accrue penalties at the rate of one pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish.
