<u>Fish Limits</u>	Site Hosts	Boundaries
 Fish size: Walleyes, saugers and saugeyes 14 inches and over. Any fish presented for weigh-in which fails to measure the official length limits shall accrue penalties at the rate of one (1) pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish. Teams are allowed to weigh a limit of five (5) fish per team, per day. Culling is legal with a limit of ten (10) fish in the live well. The tournament waters for this event shall be the Illinois River and shall include all rivers, creeks and canals connecting to the above- mentioned waters. Any waters within these boundaries posted "off limits" or "no fishing" by state or federal agencies will be off limit. Any live release areas established by the Tournament Director will be off limits. That as well as any additional off limits will be announced at the pre-tournament briefing. Only that water open to all public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's contestants. All local, state and federal regulations apply. The Illinois DNR will collect and utilize our catch for the State's spawning process.
