<p>Registration/Rules Meeting</p> <p>Location: Sioux Historic Pavilion 1079 Lake Shore Dr. . Ortonville, MN 56278 (320)839-2223</p> <p>Date: Thursday, April 27, 2017</p> <p>Registration Times: 5:00 p.m. – Registration Opens 6:00 p.m. – Registration Closes. 6:15 p.m. – Mandatory rules briefing begins. At least one (1) team member <u>MUST</u> attend.</p> <p>All anglers must be off the water by 4:00 p.m. on the day of the rules meeting.</p>	<p>Launch/Weigh-In</p> <p>Location: Lakeside Park 315 Madison Avenue Ortonville, MN 56278 (320)839-3428</p> <p>Take-off will begin at 7:00 a.m. or first safe light.</p> <p>First flight due in at 3:00 p.m.</p>	<p>Required Safety Equipment</p> <p>It is the responsibility of all anglers to have required state and federal safety equipment on board.</p> <p>At time of inspection each morning, be prepared to display 1 life jacket for each angler; 1 throwable PFD; and, demonstrate functioning kill switch.</p> <p>Inspection will be held during lineup for takeoff. Live wells must be empty.</p> <p>Keep marine band radios on Channel 72 for tournament information and use Channel 16 for emergencies.</p>
<p>Fish Limits</p> <p>Fish size: 15 inches and over. Each angler is allowed one (1) fish over 20". Four (4) fish per angler. Teams may weigh five (5) fish per team, per day. Culling is not legal.</p> <p>Any fish presented for weigh-in which fails to measure the official length limits shall accrue penalties at the rate of one (1) pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish. An 8 ounce deduction will be made for each fish presented to the bump master for weighing that is determined to be non-releasable.</p> <p>Two (2) rods per angler.</p>	<p>Site Hosts Big Stone Walleye Club Greg Peterson</p> <p>Host Hotel Econo Lodge 650 U.S. Highway 75 Ortonville, MN 56278 (320)839-2414</p> <p>Local Info Big Stone Lake Chamber of Commerce (320)839-3284 www.bigstonelake.com</p>	<p>Boundaries</p> <p>The tournament waters for this event shall be Big Stone Lake and shall include all rivers, creeks and canals connecting to the above-mentioned waters. Any waters within these boundaries posted "off limits" or "no fishing" by state or federal agencies will be off limit. Any live release areas established by the Tournament Director will be off limits. That as well as any additional off limits will be announced at the pre-tournament briefing. Only that water open to all public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's contestants. All local, state and federal regulations apply.</p>
