First flight due in at 3:00 p.m.	Required Safety Equipment It is the responsibility of all anglers to have required state and federal safety equipment on board. At time of inspection each morning, be prepared to display 1 life jacket for each angler; 1 throwable PFD; and, demonstrate functioning kill switch. Inspection will be held during lineup for takeoff. Live wells must be empty. Keep marine band radios on Channel 72 for tournament information and use Channel 16 for emergencies.
<u>Fish Limits</u>	Site Hosts	Boundaries
 Fish size: 14 inches and over. Each angler is allowed one (1) fish over 20 inches. Three (3) fish per angler. Teams may weigh five (5) fish per team, per day. Culling is allowed. One rod per angler. Any fish presented for weigh-in which fails to measure the official length limits shall accrue penalties at the rate of one (1) pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish. An 8 ounce deduction will be made for each fish presented to the bump master for weighing that is determined to be non-releasable. Please call to make cabin or slip reservations.	Cass Lake Chain of Lakes (Cass Lake, Buck Lake, Lake Andrusia, Big Wolf Lake, Kitchi Lake, Pike Bay). The tournament waters for this event shall be Cass Lake and shall include all rivers, creeks and canals connecting to the above-mentioned waters. Any waters within these boundaries posted "off limits" or "no fishing" by state or federal agencies will be off limit. Any live release areas established by the Tournament Director will be off limits. That as well as any additional off limits will be announced at the pre-tournament briefing. Only that water open to all public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's contestants. All local, state and federal regulations apply.
