Attendance is mandatory for at least one member of every team.

Anglers must be off the water by 4 p.m. on the day of the rules meeting.

Directions: Take Hwy 19 West out of Devils Lake turn Left on South Duncan Road. Follow South Duncan Road into Grahams Island State Park.

Rules Meeting

Date: Thursday, August 1

Time: 6 p.m. sharp!

**** At least one member of the team MUST attend! ****

Anglers must be off the water by 4pm on the day of the rules meeting.

*****All Teams must stop at Ed's Bait Shop on Highway 20 South in Devils Lake to clean boat prior to launching boat for pre-fishing.** Boats must be clean of all aquatic life and sprayed down with bleach water solution to disinfect the outside of the boat and live well. You will receive an inspection sticker once completed. Failure to do this will result in **DISQUALIFICATION** from the tournament. ***

Launch/Weigh-In Information

Launch Site: Grahams Island State Park –

Take-off will begin at 7:00 am or first safe light

First flight due in at 3:00pm

Weigh-in Site:
Grahams Island State Park

-Day 1 will be Friday or Saturday, and Day 2 Saturday or Sunday – Depending on weather conditions

Fish Limits

Fish size: 15" and over. Any fish presented for weigh-in which fails to measure the official length limits shall accrue penalties at the rate of one pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish

Teams are allowed to weigh a limit of five fish per team per day. Max -- seven fish in the boat. **Culling is NOT legal.**

No more than two fishing rods with one lure each, or one fishing rod with two lures per angler may be used at a time unless the state or lake limit is more restrictive, in which case the state or lake limit will prevail.

Boundaries

Fishing area will be any part of Devils Lake that is accessible by water from the launch site. All other accessible water by boat from tournament launch location shall be open to fishing unless otherwise noted at the rules meeting.

Inspections

Inspection will be held during lineup for takeoff. Livewells must be empty.

Required Safety Equipment

It is the responsibility of all anglers to have required state and federal safety equipment on board.

At time of inspection each morning, be prepared to display 1 life jacket for each angler; 1 throwable PFD; and demonstrate functioning kill switch.
