

Live wells must be empty.Keep marine band radios on Channel 72 fortournament information and useChannel 16 for emergencies.
<b>Fish Limits</b> Fish size: 15 inches and over. Each angler is allowed one (1) fish over 23 inches. Five (5) fish limit. Any fish presented for weigh-in which fails to measure the official length limits shall accrue penalties at the rate of one (1) pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish. An 8 ounce deduction will be made for each fish presented to the bump master for weighing that is determined to be non-releasable. Any waters within these boundaries posted "off limits" or "no fishing" by state or federal agencies will be off limit. Any live release areas established by the Tournament Director will be off limits. That as well as any additional off limits will be announced at the pre-tournament briefing. Only that water open to all public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's contestants.
