<p align="center"><b><u>Registration/Rules Meeting</u></b></p> <p><b>Location:</b> Lake City Sportsman’s Club 2200 S Oak Street Lake City, MN 55041</p> <p><b>Date:</b> Wednesday, September 29, 2021</p> <p><b>Registration Times:</b> 5:00 p.m. – Registration Opens 6:00 p.m. – Registration Closes. <b>6:15 p.m. – Mandatory rules briefing begins. At least one (1) team member MUST attend.</b></p> <p>All anglers must be off the water by 4:00 p.m. on the day of the rules meeting.</p>	<p align="center"><b><u>Launch/Weigh-In</u></b></p> <p>The Lake City Marina 201 S Franklin ST Lake City, MN 55041</p> <p>Take-off will begin at 7:30 a.m. or first safe light.</p> <p>Weigh-in begins at 3:30 p.m.</p>	<p align="center"><b><u>Required Safety Equipment</u></b></p> <p>It is the responsibility of all anglers to have required state and federal safety equipment on board.</p> <p>At time of inspection each morning, be prepared to display 1 life jacket for each angler; 1 throwable PFD; and, demonstrate functioning kill switch.</p> <p>Inspection will be held during lineup for takeoff. Live wells must be empty.</p> <p>Keep marine band radios on Channel 72 for tournament information and use Channel 16 for emergencies.</p>
<p align="center"><b><u>Fish Limits</u></b></p> <p>Fish size: Walleye, Sauger, and Saugeye 15 inches minimum.</p> <p>Teams are allowed to weigh a limit of five (5) fish per team, per day. Each angler is allowed one (1) fish over 20". No single angler may have more than four (4) fish in possession at any time. Release any fish not to be weighed in prior to making final run to check-in.</p> <p><b>Culling is NOT allowed On boarder waters of MN that are shared with Wisconsin.</b></p> <p>Any fish presented for weigh-in which fails to measure the official length limits shall accrue penalties at the rate of one (1) pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish. An 8-ounce deduction will be made for each fish presented to the bump master for weighing that is determined to be non-releasable.</p>	<p align="center"><b><u>Site Host</u></b></p> <p>Lake City Chamber of Commerce 100 E Lyon Ave Lake City, MN 55041 651.345.4123 <a href="#">Website</a></p>	<p align="center"><b><u>Boundaries</u></b></p> <p>The tournament waters for this event shall be the Mississippi River Pools 3,4,5. Lock at your own risk Launch in pool 4. Any waters within these boundaries posted "off limits" or "no fishing" by state or federal agencies will be off limit. Any live release areas established by the Tournament Director will be off limits. That as well as any additional off limits will be announced at the pre-tournament briefing. Only water open to all public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's contestants. All local, state and federal regulations apply.</p>
<p align="center"><b><u>LIVE BAIT / CLEAN WATER NOTICE:</u></b></p> <p>The use of LIVE bait, including minnows, suckers, willow cats, etc. IS allowed BUT ONLY Under these conditions. By Minnesota law all live bait on this boarder water MUST be purchased from a licensed dealer in MN that is open to the public. It is against the law to transport live bait acquired in another state or privately held bait into or from one water body to another.
