| Location: Petenwell County Park Shelter 2004 Bighorn Drive, Arkdale, WI 54613 Date: Thursday, May 4, 2023 Registration Times: 4:00 p.m. – Registration Opens 5:00 p.m. – Registration Closes. 5:15 p.m. – Mandatory rules briefing begins. At least one (1) team member <u>MUST</u> attend. All anglers must be off the water by 4:00 p.m. on the day of the rules meeting. | Launch & Weigh-in: Petenwell County Park Boat Launch, 2004 Bighorn Drive, Arkdale, WI 54613 Take-off will begin at 7:00 a.m. or first safe light. Weigh-In begins at 3:00 p.m. | It is the responsibility of all anglers to have required state and federal safety equipment on board. At time of inspection each morning, be prepared to display 1 life jacket for each angler; 1 throwable PFD; and, demonstrate functioning kill switch. Inspection will be held during lineup for takeoff. Live wells must be empty. Keep marine band radios on Channel 72 for tournament information and use Channel 16 for emergencies. |
| Fish Limits | | Boundaries |
| Fish size: Walleye - minimum length is 15", but walleye from 20" to 28" may not be kept, and only (1) fish per angler over 28" is allowed. Teams are allowed to weigh a limit of five (5) fish per team, per day. When your 10th fish goes into the livewell you are done fishing for the day. Release any fish not to be weighed in prior to making the final run to checkin. Culling is NOT allowed. Any fish presented for weigh-in which fails to measure the official length limits shall accrue penalties at the rate of one (1) pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish. An 8-ounce deduction will be made for each fish presented to the bump master for weighing that is determined to be non-releasable. | A 60-inch shaft Lowrance GHOST trolling motor will be added to the Payout at this Petenwell event, Cass Lake event and World Walleye Championship! \$3,749.00 value each! | The tournament waters for this event shall be the waters of Lake Petenwell and shall include all rivers, creeks and canals connecting to the above - mentioned waters. Any waters within these boundaries posted "off limits" or "no fishing" by state or federal agencies will be off limits. Any live release areas established by the Tournament director will be off limits. That as well as any additional off limits will be announced at the pre-tournament briefing. Only water open to all public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's contestants. All local, state and federal regulations apply. |
