Pre-Event On-Site Check-In/Rules Meeting

Date: Thursday, May 29, 2025

Mandatory On-site Check-in Times:

4:00 p.m. – Check in Opens 5:00 p.m. – Check in Closes. 5:15 p.m. – Mandatory rules briefing begins. At least one (1) team member MUST attend.

All anglers must be off the water by 4:00 p.m. on the day of the rules meeting.

Take-off/Weigh-In

Take-off:

Indian Creek Recreation Area - Launch 12905 288th Ave Mobridge, SD 57601

Take-off will begin at 7:00 a.m. or first safe light.

Weigh-in:

Wrigley Square 1st Ave E. & Railroad St. E. Mobridge, SD 57601

Weigh-in begins at 3:15 p.m.

Anglers MUST use launch at Indian Creek.

Required Safety Equipment

It is the responsibility of all anglers to have required state and federal safety equipment on board.

At time of inspection each morning, be prepared to display 1 life jacket for each angler; 1 throwable PFD; and, demonstrate functioning kill switch.

Inspection will be held during lineup for takeoff. Live wells must be empty.

Keep marine band radios on Channel 72 for tournament information and use Channel 16 for emergencies.

Fish Limits

Fish size: 15 inches and over. Walleye, Sauger/Saugeye.

Teams are allowed to weigh a limit of five (5) fish per team, per day. Each angler is allowed one (1) fish over 20". When your 8th fish goes in to the livewell you are done fishing for the day. **Culling is not allowed.** Please be prepared to keep or donate all fish brought to weigh-in.

Any fish presented for weigh-in which fails to measure the official length limits shall accrue penalties at the rate of one (1) pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish.

Boundaries

The tournament waters for this event shall be the South Dakota Waters of Lake Oahe north of the US Hwy 212 Bridge and shall include all rivers, creeks and canals connecting to the above - mentioned waters. Any waters within boundaries posted "off limits" or "no fishing" by state or federal agencies will be off limit. Any live release areas established by the Tournament director will be off limits. That as well as any additional off limits will be announced at the pretournament briefing. Only water open to all public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's contestants. All local, state and federal regulations apply.
