Location: Lake Brophy Park Visitor Center 2715 Brophy Landing NW Alexandria, MN 56308 Date: Wednesday, October 8 th , 2025 Registration Times: 4:00 p.m. – Registration Opens 5:00 p.m. – Registration Closes. 5:15 p.m. – Mandatory rules briefing begins. At least one (1) team member MUST attend. All anglers must be off the water by 4:00 p.m. on the day of the rules meeting.	Launch: Anglers may use any landing they wish on the chain, except Lake Carlos State Park. EXCEPTION – you may use Lake Carlos State Park only if you are staying at the park. Take-off: 7:30 a.m. or first safe light offshore on Lake Carlos. Weigh-In: 3:30 p.m. Lake Carlos State Park (Amphitheater) 2601 County Rd 38 NE Carlos, MN 56319	It is the responsibility of all anglers to have required state and federal safety equipment on board. At time of inspection each morning, be prepared to display 1 life jacket for each angler; 1 throwable PFD; and, demonstrate functioning kill switch. Inspection will be held during lineup for takeoff. Live wells must be empty. Keep marine band radios on Channel 72 for tournament information and use Channel 16 for emergencies.
Fish Limits		Boundaries
Fish size: Walleye, 15 inch minimum. Teams may weigh five (5) fish per team, per day. Each angler is allowed one (1) fish over 20". No single angler may have more than five (5) fish in possession at any time. Release any fish not to be weighed in prior to making final run to check-in. Culling is allowed . Any fish presented for weigh-in which fails to measure the official length limits shall accrue penalties at the rate of one (1) pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish. An 8-ounce deduction will be made for each fish presented to the bump master for weighing that is determined to be non- releasable.		Le Homme Dieu Chain of Lakes (Lake Le Homme Dieu, Lake Carlos, Lake Geneva, Lake Victoria, Lake Darling, and Lake Jessie) The tournament waters for this event shall be Le Homme Dieu Chain and shall include all rivers, creeks and canals connecting to the abovementioned waters. Any waters within these boundaries posted "off Limit" or "no fishing" by state or federal agencies will be off limit. Any live release areas established by the Tournament Director will be off limits. That as well as any additional off limits will be announced at the pretournament briefing. Only that water open to all public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's contestants. All local, state and federal regulations apply.
