At least one (1) team member MUST attend.</p> <p>All anglers must be off the water by 4:00 p.m. on the day of the rules meeting.</p> <p>Please do not bring boats to rules meeting.</p>	<p>Launch: Bitter Lake Access (East) HWY 1 Central Pont TWP, SD</p> <p>Weigh-In: 476 US-12 E Webster, SD 57274</p> <p>Friday & Saturday August 21-22, 2026</p> <p>Take-off will begin at 7:00 a.m. or first safe light.</p> <p>Weigh-In begins at 3:30 p.m.</p> <p>Anglers MUST launch at Bitter Lake access.</p>	<p>It is the responsibility of all anglers to have required state and federal safety equipment on board.</p> <p>At time of inspection each morning, be prepared to display 1 life jacket for each angler; 1 throwable PFD; and demonstrate functioning kill switch.</p> <p>Inspection will be held during the lineup for takeoff. Live wells must be empty.</p> <p>Keep marine band radios on Channel 72 for tournament information and use Channel 16 for emergencies.</p>
<p>Fish Limits</p> <p>Fish size: Walleye 15 inches minimum.</p> <p>Teams are allowed to weigh a limit of five (5) fish per team, per day. Each angler is allowed one (1) fish over 20". Culling (High-Grading) is NOT allowed.</p> <p>Any fish presented for weigh-in which fails to measure the official length limits shall accrue penalties at the rate of one (1) pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish.</p>	<p>Site Host: Webster Area Chamber of Commerce 420 E Highway 12 Webster, SD 57274 (605)345-4668 Website</p> <p>Host Hotel: Boomers Outback Motel 300 US-12 Webster, SD 57274 (605)345-3323 Website</p>	<p>Boundaries</p> <p>The tournament waters for this event shall be the waters of Bitter Lake and shall include all rivers, creeks and canals connecting to the above-mentioned waters. Any waters within these boundaries posted "off limits" or "no fishing" by state or federal agencies will be off limits. Any live release areas established by the Tournament director will be off limits. That as well as any additional off limits will be announced at the pretournament briefing. Only water open to all public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's contestants. All local, state and federal regulations apply.</p>
